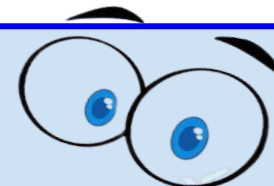

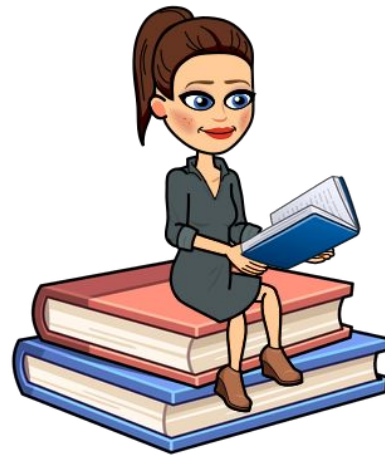

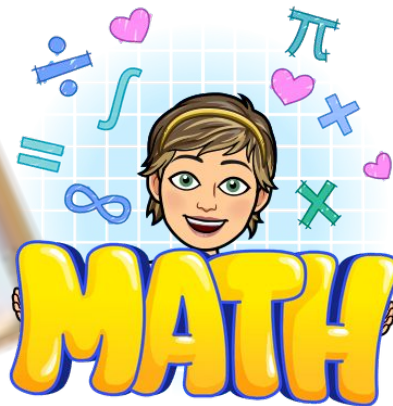
Math Block 1:
