

<b>awe</b>	-a feeling of fear or nervous wonder and respect
<b>awesome</b>	-causing feelings of awe
<b>catastrophe</b>	-something that causes great loss and suffering; a terrible disaster
<b>collide</b>	-to come together with great force
<b>collision</b>	-the act of colliding
<b>consequence</b>	-a result or outcome -importance
<b>deceive</b>	-to cause to believe something that is not true
<b>deceptive</b>	-intended to or likely to deceive or mislead
<b>deception</b>	-an act of deceiving

<b>fatality</b>	-a death resulting from an accident or a disaster
<b>improvise</b>	-to compose or perform without preparation -to make do with whatever is on hand
<b>loom</b>	-machine or device for weaving cloth -to appear in a sudden and frightening way -to get frighteningly close
<b>lull</b>	-to cause to relax -a temporary calm or quiet period
<b>placid</b>	-calm and peaceful
<b>predicament</b>	-a difficult or trying situation
<b>priority</b>	-the state or condition of being before another in importance or time
<b>reinforce</b>	-to increase or strengthen

<b>reinforcements</b>	-extra people such as soldiers or police sent to provide help
<b>stern</b>	-the rear part of a boat -unpleasantly severe
<b>treacherous</b>	-not to be trusted -actually dangerous while seeming to be safe.
