Independent clause + dependent clause = Complex Sentence

Independent Clauses (mommy & daddy sentences)

- Sentence that can exist on its own.
- has subject & predicate

Dependent Clauses (kid sentences)

- cannot exist on their own!
- has a subject & predicate

also has subordinate conjunction

after, although, as, because, before, even if, even though, if, in order that, once, provided that, rather than, since, so that, than, that, though, unless, until, when, whenever, where, whereas, wherever, whether, while, why
