Don’t choose two details that caused the same problem. Third, what solution did you use to solve this problem during your reading of the article? Lastly, show that you solved your problem by providing what you learned by using the solutions and explain how your new knowledge better helped your understanding of the text.**
2. Review the article and discuss 2 details that surprised you. **Choose two different categories of surprise.** Why did each detail surprise you and what do they suggest? Finally, tell what category of surprise each represents? **See your notes on how to begin your response.**

3. What challenged, changed, or confirmed what you already know? Be sure to provide information about the detail in text and what your new thoughts are in relation to the text details.
