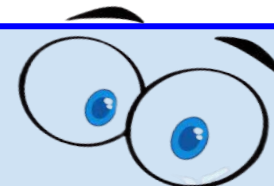

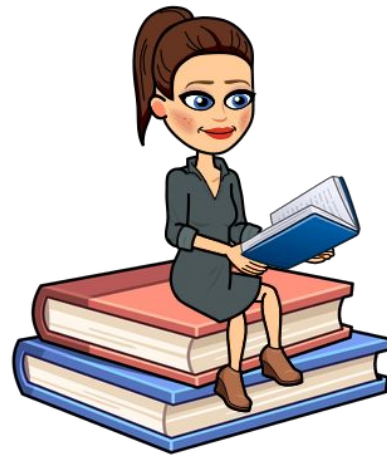

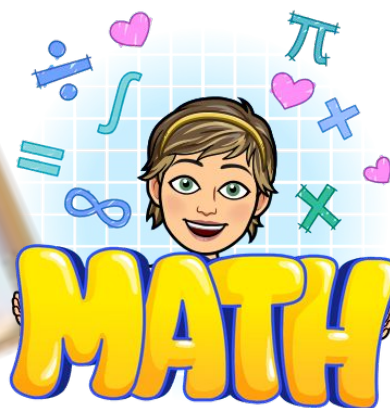
**Math Block 1:**
