We will have a spelling test on List #7 words (Irregular Plurals) on Friday, October 23. Students can go on www.spellingcity.com/HWorden1 to help them study. Making flashcards or having a parent quiz them is also helpful! We will continue our study of Greek and Latin Roots in Foundational Skills. In Night of the Spadefoot Toads, we will be reading Chapters 13-15. Our reading skill focus continues to be Language Analysis. Our grammar skills will include compound sentences and indefinite pronouns. We will continue to work on our narratives and start sentence diagramming.</p>
