

Region	An area defined by common features or conditions
Climate	The pattern of weather in a place over a long period of time
Dissent	Disagreement
Proprietor	Someone who owns land or property
Diverse	People from different countries and backgrounds
Barter	To trade one good for another

Export	A product sold to other countries (think: exit)
Import	A product bought in from other countries
Raw materials	Resources that can be made into products
Mercantilism	Popular economic idea thought that countries benefited from trade when they exported more than imported
Triangular trade	Trade that had three parts

Artisans	Skilled workers and craftspeople Ex: blacksmiths, carpenters
Classes	Society groups
Slavery	A system in which people are bought and sold as if they were property
Middle Passage	A terrifying journey to the Americas
Uprisings	An act of resistance or rebellion

King Philip's War	A war with Metacom against the colonists
Ally	A military partner
Treaty	A formal agreement between countries
Pontiac's Rebellion	An attack on British settlers led by Pontiac.
Proclamation of 1763	An order by King George III that blocked colonists from settling lands west of the Appalachian Mountains
