## Reading

This week we will read “The Moon Seems to Change and Treasure in the Trees”. This will be the start of our Unit 1 B Lesson. We will also examine main idea, text features, information from illustrations, and point of view.

## Grammar

Our grammar skills are focused on nouns as subjects and subject/ past tense verb agreement.

## Phonics

Our phonics skill this week is long e, long a, and long o vowel digraph patterns.

## Spelling

We will begin to review and practice the Unit 1B: Lesson 1-5 words this week. This week’s spelling words are a review of Unit 1A. **There will be a spelling test this Friday.**

## Writing

Throughout this module students will focus on ideas, information, illustrations, and introducing a topic. The students will also complete their final copy of the Autumn Acrostic poem.

## Math

We will continue to explore solving number stories using two operations, solving problems including multiples of equal groups including making sense of multiplying by 0 and 1, solving multiplication array problems and creating mathematical representations for solving division problems .

## Social Studies

We will begin learning about what makes a good community and what makes us proud of where we live. Then we will learn about the location of communities by studying maps and locating objects and locations on the map.
