Reading

This week we will be focusing on three different stories; two that we have read already and one new story. These stories include: *Location, Location, Location*, *The Case of the Gasping Garbage* and *Thunder Cake*. We will begin to understand how characters identify and solve problems, what motivates a characters actions and how those motivations impact a story.

Grammar

Our grammar skills are focused on verbs and pronouns. We will start by gaining an understanding of how to use verbs that end in -y and irregular verbs in a sentence. Then we will learn to identify pronouns and use them in sentences.

Phonics

Our phonics skill this week focuses on vowel digraphs; ee, ea, ai, oa and ow in words.

Spelling

We will review and practice the Lesson 11-15 words this week. Using, getting, easiest, swimming, heavier, greatest, pleased, emptied, leaving, worried, strangest, freezing, funniest, angrier, shopped.

Writing

The students will work on finishing their narrative they have been working on all week. This process includes drafting, revising to include details and dialogue, editing, publishing and presenting.

Math

We will finish Unit 1 this week . We will be reviewing time, elapsed time, bar graphs, multiplication, and assessing students on Friday .

Science

Using what we learned about the Scientific Method we will start to plan an investigation and use scientific tools to investigate our experiment. We will be determining which liquid melts faster and why?
