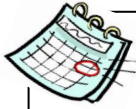

A PEEK AT THE WEEK

Reading: Today the students completed the writing portion of the unit 2 test. Tomorrow the students will take the multiple choice test over the unit 2 skills. To end our week, we will introduce the unit 2 small group project the students will complete next week in class.

Since the students worked so hard throughout this entire unit, we will also be showing movies related to our essential question: *How do humans and animals relate to one another?* The students will have a choice between two movies to watch.
