## What's Happening in our Classrooms

### Mr. Baldermann

Science/SS: This week we finished our unit on resources and climate. Next week we go back to Social Studies and look at the European explorers that came to North America.

### Mrs. Brost

#### ELA -

Novel- Shells: Short Test on Thursday. Vocab: fiercely, prejudiced, assured, craned, stupor

Reading Skills- Compare and Contrast characters and stories, Theme.

Foundational Skill- Compound Words

Grammar- Linking Verbs and verb phrases.

Spelling- List 11 Words with Schwa

*All students need an independent reading NOVEL. Please continue to read 20 minutes every school night. Please continue to check Google Classroom for assignments that need to be completed.*

Social Studies- Lesson 5: Routes of Exploration to the New World

Text p. 65- 79. WB 29-36.

#### Math- Unit 3

Our current assessment topics include: Read and write Decimals, Compare decimals to the thousandths, Round decimals, Add and subtract decimals, Plot points on a coordinate grid, add and subtract mixed numbers, multiply fractions, Multiply and divide whole numbers and fractions.

Students can access math notes in their math Google Classroom. They have also taken notes in their math spiral. Students should be reviewing their notes on a nightly basis. They may use IXL for skills review and Reflex for fact review.

ELA: Next week in ReadyGEN, we will begin a new story called Shells. It is very short, and our selection test on it will be Thursday, Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>. Our spelling list is #11 this week. The words have schwa sounds.. That test will also be on Thursday, Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>. Compare/contrast of books and characters are our foundation skills.

### Mrs. Worden

We will be on List #11 in Word Analysis/ Spelling, which is words with Schwa sounds. Our test will be on Thursday, November 19. We will be reading "Shells," a short story with a selection test on the story on Thursday as well. Our reading skills include compare/contrast and theme. Our foundational skill continues to be compound words. Our grammar skill will be verbs. Please have students read 20 minutes each school night. Thank you for all you are doing at home as well!
