We will be reviewing 4th Grade skills, completing the IXL Diagnostic and beginning Unit 1 in Everyday Math.

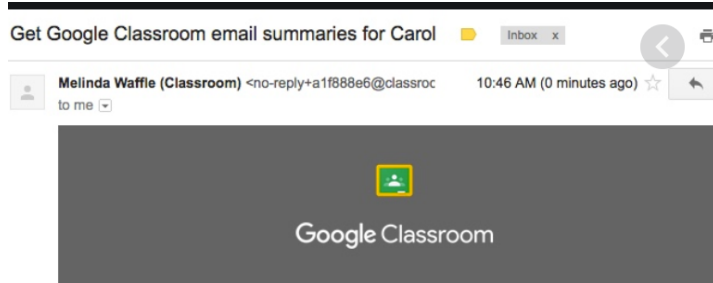
Mrs. Sieger

Mrs. Worden

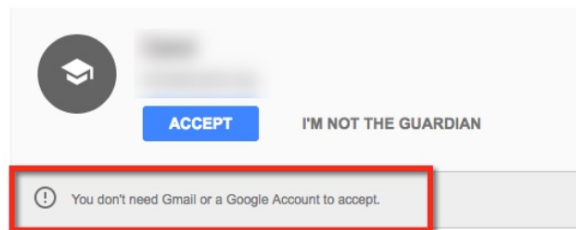
