written in their assignment books. ***I have added a Halloween Library to my Google Classroom. Students can choose a book and read along. There are enough books to read one each day in October! We will be taking a mask break outside during class each day-weather permitting.

Ms. Delatte's Instructional Math: Unit 2 - Multiplication Number Sense in Digits. This week we will be covering estimating products and reviewing the unit. Students will have a quiz on unit 2 on Wednesday, Oct. 22. Grades can be found on PowerSchool. Students will be writing in their assignment notebooks everyday.

We had a great week back in school this week! The students did an excellent job getting back into the "in school" routine. ELA class will be from 7:45-10:00 each day. This week we will be finishing iLit Unit 1 "Saint Louis Armstrong Beach" by Brenda Woods by completing the Unit 1 benchmark assessment. We will be starting Unit 2 "Don't Call Me Hero" By Ray Villareal. Encourage your child to read each day for 15-20 minutes. My Zoom will still be active for a remote learner in the class. We will also be using zoom to work on Aimsweb reading passages, instead of using the paper prompts. Thank you for all of your help during remote learning, it went very smoothly.
