**Mrs. Lane's Instructional ELA:**

We are continuing to read our second unit of iLit, *Sahara Special*. The students are doing a great job with classroom discussions about this story. Enjoy your Thanksgiving break!

**Mrs. Lane's Instructional Math:** In math, we will begin lesson 7.

**Mrs. Berwanger's Instructional Science and Social Studies:**

As we transition back to remote learning, please make sure to provide your child with space to help keep them focused and organized. During this time, we will only focus on Science. All materials were sent home in a ziploc bag. We will begin with the book, "**Changes to the Earth's Surface.**" Packets that were provided will go along with this

book. Feel free to look through it, but please wait to complete any activities.

**Mrs. Berwanger's 5th Grade Instructional Math Class:** As we transition back to remote learning, please make sure to provide your child with space to help keep them focused and organized. We will continue to work on our individual goals and new material daily in stations. Every student was sent home with a binder. This includes materials that will be used with the upcoming lessons along with goal practice. Keeping this binder organized, will help students during zoom.

**Ms. Delatte's Instructional 5th grade ELA:** We are returning to Remote Learning on Monday, November 30th. Students were sent home with folders to use while we are Remote. Please make sure your child's Ipad is charged each day, they have easy access to folders, and they are working in a space that they can focus on school. We will be reading Chapters 25 and 26 this week in our book Alamo Wars and completing assignments in Unit 1, Lesson 13 and 14 in the iLit program. Daily homework is to read for 15 minutes per day. Your child's new remote schedule was downloaded as an app onto their Ipads. They can open it and click to connect to Zoom for each class.

**Ms. Delatte's Instructional Math:** We are returning to Remote Learning on November 30th. All students were sent home with their Digits binder. We will begin Unit 4 - Dividing by 1-Digit Numbers. Current grades can be found on PowerSchool. Please remember, your child can always access IXL to work on their math skills.
