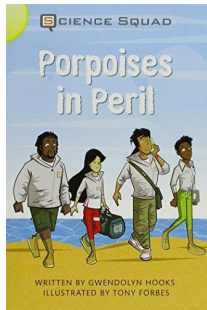

Referring- hinting to or implying something 8. Stable- steady, balanced, or even/level 9. Rickety- wobbly, unstable, or worn down 10. Cluttered- something that is untidy, messy, or piled up 11. Peculiarly- acting strange, odd, or weird 12. Snorkeling- swimming or diving into the water with masks to find fish or coral 13. Temperature- warmth or heat; hot or cold. Usually measured with a number in degrees.
